## 48-026: FIRST YEAR SEMINAR: ARCHITECTURE EDITION II

The first-year seminar (part 2) introduces students to opportunities at Carnegie Mellon University and beyond. The goal of this course is to encourage students to pursue their interests inside and outside of the School of Architecture by introducing a range of opportunities, including study abroad experiences, internships, academic minors/additional majors, and research opportunities. The introduction of the study abroad process and travel options will encourage students to consider integrating a study away experience into their academic curriculum. Students will explore their additional academic interests through learning about the different academic colleges at CMU. The presentation of the Architecture Experience Program (AXP) will engage students in considering future plans for earning AXP hours and understanding the process of securing an architectural internship. Students will be introduced to the process of researching an interest area to draw connections inside and outside of the field of architecture. Additional topical areas to be covered in the seminar will include an evaluation of the previous semester, scholarship/academic funding opportunities, ethical decision making, design resume writing/branding, and engaging with the Career and Professional Development Center.
