The first-year seminar (part 2) introduces students to opportunities at Carnegie Mellon University and beyond. The goal of this course is to encourage students to pursue their interests inside and outside of the School of Architecture by introducing a range of opportunities, including study abroad experiences, professional networking, and research scaffolding. The introduction of the study abroad process and travel options will encourage students to consider integrating a study away experience into their academic curriculum. Students will be introduced to the pathway of professional licensure through AXP. Students will explore various career options, visit a professional job fair, and engage with working architects. Students will experience the process of researching an interest area to draw connections inside and outside of the field of architecture. Additional topical areas to be covered in the seminar will include an evaluation of the previous semester, scholarship/academic funding opportunities related to research, and engaging with the Career and Professional Development Center.
