

48-200: Architecture Design Studio: Poiesis Studio 3 Units: 18 Coordinator: Laura Garófalo

This studio will explore morphology in relation to patterns of climate, programmatic organization, and sociocultural and ecological context. We will work towards an understanding of how the relationships between pattern, space, and function are informed by sociocultural and ecological conditions. Students will be introduced to techniques of site and building design that use ecological, and environmental considerations as generative tools. Iterative drawings and models will guide the evolution of compositional and formal strategies that address interactions between buildings, bodies, and systems and landscapes.
